- ❖ Country-led choice of topics, identification of priorities



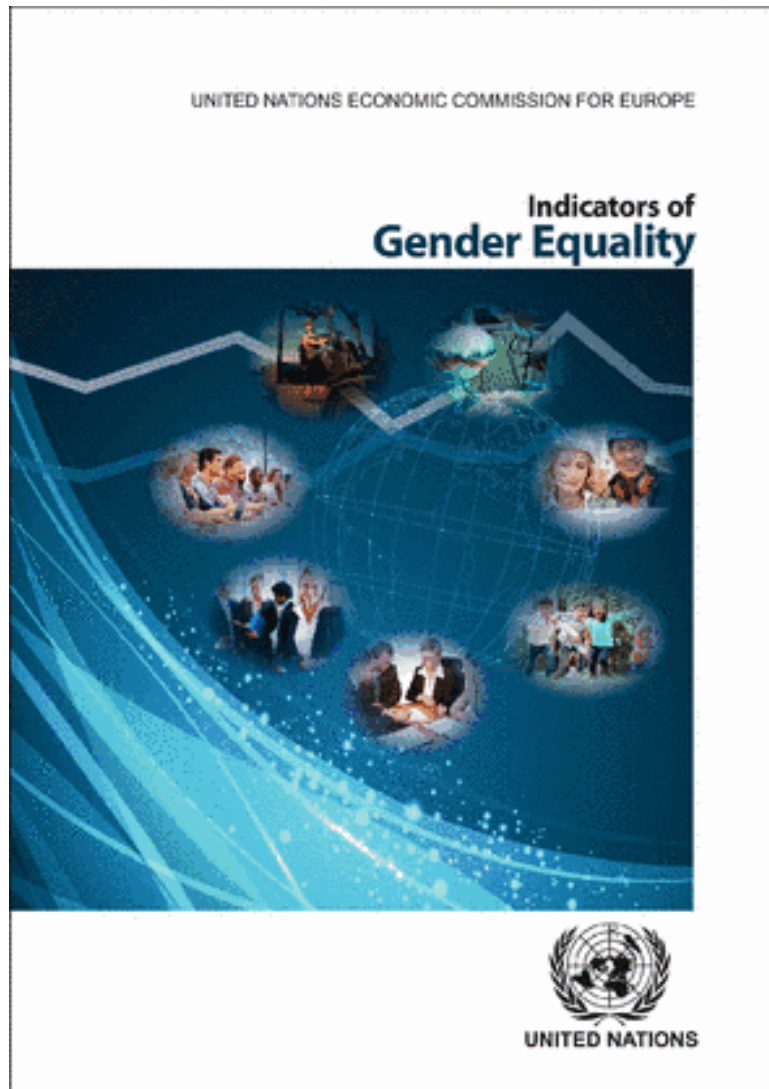

- ❖ Developing gender statistics: a practical tool (2010)

Indicators of gender equality



- ❖ UNECE regional set based on the global minimum
- ❖ Measure progress towards gender-related policy goals
- ❖ 42 headline, 71 supporting indicators
- ❖ Organized by the Beijing domains

Valuing unpaid household service work



- ❖ Developing guidelines
- ❖ Defining, measuring, valuing work
- ❖ Household Satellite Accounts
- ❖ Implementation & measurement challenges
- ❖ Scheduled for completion in 2017

Household power & decisions

- ❖ Gender inequalities in the household reinforce, and are reinforced by, gender inequalities in society
- ❖ No robust indicators
- ❖ Some work already done for UNECE Indicators of gender equality

- ❖ Health
- ❖ Education...
