**Ethical Principles when collecting & sharing data on VAW**

- data disaggregated by sex
- reflect gender issues
- based on concepts & definitions
- Stereotypes of social + cultural factors
- \* Relationship between women + men are more relevant than biol. differences
- \* Monitoring + evaluation
- WHY?

DATA SOURCES - surveys, admin.

132 indicators: in 9 subheadings

- assess int'l. differences
- assess intertemp. changes
- situation in a given country
- data disaggregated by sex + anonymized (properly labelled) incl. meta-data

- violence incr.

Report of abuse: Still few

- more physical
- less threats, mobbing etc.
- more from current partner
- less from former partner
